DVMA has established this scholarship for veterinary medical students from Delaware to assure the continuation of expert animal care and the scientific advancement of veterinary medicine.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

1. Student must be a Delaware resident as defined by at least one of the following criteria:
 - (a) Graduate of a Delaware high school,
 - (b) Resident of Delaware for at least three years, and/or
 - (c) Permanent mailing address in Delaware.
2. Student must have a grade point average of at least 2.5 to apply.
3. Scholarship is open to veterinary students having completed their first, second, or third year of veterinary school.
4. Previous recipients may apply; however, first preference will be given to new recipients.
