This budget information is provided to assist you in estimating your monthly budget and managing your available financial resources (e.g., employment earnings, financial aid, and assistance from family members) for the 2011-12 academic year. You should refer to the base expense budget given below when estimating your expenses. The average monthly living allowances listed below were derived from the 2011-12 Cost of Attendance figures developed by the Office of Student Financial Services. Your actual expenses may vary from the “average” cost of attendance for your class. Consequently, you should calculate your monthly expenses based upon your anticipated expenses for the 12-month academic year. These monthly estimates should be derived to ensure you have enough funds to complete the year. Remember, your costs and financial aid awards are for the fall, winter, spring (2011-12 AY) and summer (2012-13AY) quarters (August 2011 to August 2012).
