Transcript Key

COLLEGES AND PROGRAMS: Midwestern University-Glendale, Arizona, consists of 5 colleges: The Arizona College of Osteopathic Medicine (AZCOM), College of Pharmacy-Glendale (CPG), College of Health Sciences (CHS), College of Dental Medicine-Arizona (CDMA), Arizona College of Optometry (AZCOPT).

ACCREDITATION: Midwestern University is fully accredited by The Higher Learning Commission, a Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools. Each College and/or program is also accredited by their own professional accrediting body.

CREDIT UNIT: Course credit is expressed in quarter credit units; each quarter is 10 weeks in length, plus one week of final exams.

ABBREVIATIONS:

QUAL (calculated earned credits)

POINTS (quality points)

EARNED (total credits earned)

GRADING SYSTEM: All colleges and programs are graded based on the Alpha 4.0 grading system. Exceptions: Arizona College of Osteopathic Medicine (AZCOM) students matriculating prior to September 2007 were graded based on a numeric scale of zero to 100.

TRANSFER CREDIT: The names of transfer institutions the student attended are noted on the transcript. A summary line indicates the number of quarter credits/units accepted from each institution.

COURSE REPEAT POLICY: Students may repeat a course failure/low pass course as approved by their college. Credit is given only once. Previous grades for repeated courses are retained on the transcript. Only the most recent grade/points are used in calculating the student's cumulative GPA.

COURSE NUMBERING: Upper Division (Junior/Senior) 300-400. Upper division and Graduate level -400. Graduate Level (Master) 500-600. Doctoral (Pharmacy) 1500-1800 (500-700 prior to 2008). Doctoral (Medicine, Podiatry, Dental, Optometry,) 1500-1800.

TRANSCRIPT VALIDATION: Official transcripts are printed on light blue security paper with a dark blue border. The name MIDWESTERN UNIVERISTY in small print appears across the entire page. When photocopied, the word "copy" should appear across the face of the document. A raised university seal is not required. The official signature of the registrar "Christy Schenk" is in white on a light blue background and a validation finger print is located at the top right hand corner of the page. The message "student copy" is stamped on all unofficial transcripts.

GRADE POINT CALCULATION:

Multiply each course credit by the numeric value of the grade awarded = quality points (QPTS)

Divide total quality points (QPTS) by the calculated earned credits (earned) = GPA
