



## MWU Preceptor Benefits

### Library at Downers Grove Campus and Glendale Campus

Midwestern University provides access to all of its library resources for each academic year that you currently precept a Physician Assistant student. Access premier databases that MWU pays for, including UpToDate, DynaMed, Clinical Key, Cochrane Library, CINAHL, Visual DX, Micromedex, Natural Standard as well as many ebooks, print books and full-text articles.

The Physician Assistant program provides Preceptor library ID and password for PA preceptors only. Keep it confidential and do not share it with others. On an annual basis, the college will determine your eligibility to receive a library ID and password and provide you with instructions for setting up your login. All Preceptor library ID and passwords will expire annually on July 1st and are only renewed for active preceptors.

## **CONTINUING MEDICAL EDUCATION**

**Category II:** MDs and Physician Assistants will receive hour-for-hour Category II CME for precepting Physician Assistant students. Nurse practitioners can also receive Category II CME letters, but should consult the AANP to determine if the credit is acceptable. **Category II CME letters are sent at the conclusion of the clinical year.** (At present, the AOA does not honor CME credit for precepting of Physician Assistant students by DO preceptors.)

**Category I:** The MWU Physician Assistant Program is now accredited to award **up to 20 hours of AAPA Category I CME for Preceptors.** Only Physician Assistant preceptors are eligible. Reconciliation and award of all Category I CME credits are completed at the conclusion of the clinical year.

Lastly, all preceptors are eligible to attend, **free of charge**, the MWU Physician Assistant Program annual **PANCE/PANRE Review Course** which offers an average of **30 AAPA approved Category I CME** credits during a four-day symposium on campus in Glendale, Arizona.
