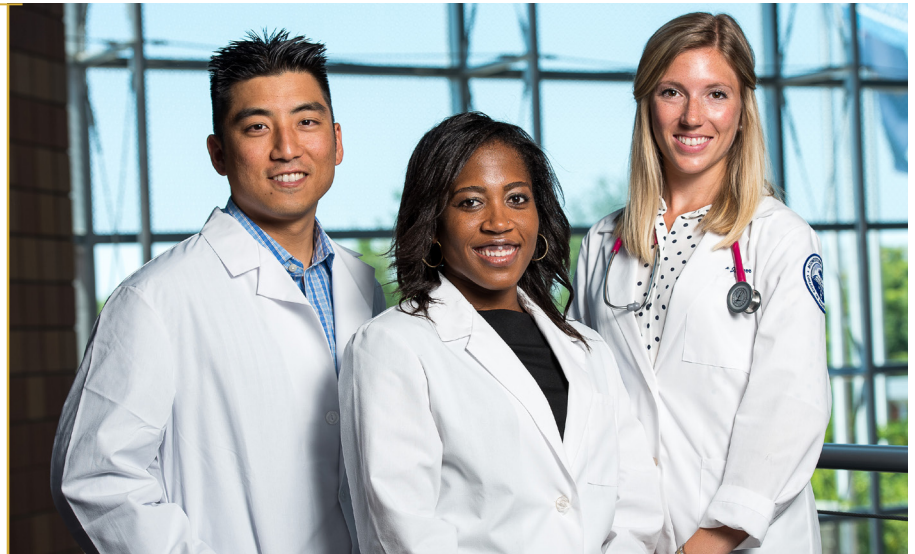

Midwestern University Multispecialty Clinic (Opened 2007)

- Clinical Psychology, Family Medicine, Foot and Ankle Services, Osteopathic Manipulative Medicine, Pharmacy Services, Speech-Language Institute, Physical Therapy Institute
- Licensed healthcare providers and/or students under supervision provide care

Midwestern University Dental Institute (Opened June 2010)

- Comprehensive family dentistry, including advanced imaging, oral surgery, pediatric dentistry, orthodontics
- Third- and fourth-year CDMA students provide care with faculty supervision

Midwestern University Eye Institute (Opened October 2010)

- Comprehensive family eye and vision care, including eye exams, glasses and contact lenses, disease screenings, sports vision training, visual rehabilitation services, pediatric care, ocular prosthetics
- Third- and fourth-year AZCOPT students provide care with faculty supervision

Midwestern University Animal Health Institute (Opened December 2014)

- Companion Animal Clinic: comprehensive small animal care, including urgent care, internal medicine, diagnostic imaging, surgery, dentistry, wellness, senior pet care, canine physical rehabilitation
- Equine and Bovine Center: large animal medicine and training
- Diagnostic Pathology Center: necropsy and pathology services and training
- Third- and fourth-year CVM students provide care with faculty supervision

One Health Initiative:

Midwestern University is committed to the principles of One Health, which fosters interdisciplinary cooperation between various human and veterinary medical specialties to fight disease, improve research and knowledge, and provide more complete care for all patients. The University has introduced several key initiatives that encourage students and faculty from all programs to collaborate and share expertise in both medical education and practice.

MWU Impact in Arizona

Local Presence:

Midwestern University's presence in Glendale has created over 850 campus-based jobs and has linked over 8,000 healthcare professionals from around the United States to Glendale as preceptors. The University has invested \$425 million in Glendale and is the home of Arizona's largest medical school and the state's only veterinary college.

Community Service:

Midwestern University faculty and students are actively engaged in community service through University-sponsored events, alliances with healthcare organizations such as the American Diabetes Association, and work study programs. Midwestern students and employees provide thousands of hours of community service annually by participating in a wide variety of outreach programs, health screenings, and education throughout the state.

Arizona Healthcare Impact:

As of September 2017, almost 9,100 healthcare professionals have graduated from all of Midwestern's programs, with over 40% remaining in Arizona to practice, helping to address critical shortages statewide.

Institute for Healthcare Innovation:

Midwestern University continues to expand its clinical and research capabilities to provide critical resources for both human and animal medicine in keeping with the University's commitment to One Health. The Institute for Healthcare Innovation (IHI) promotes collaborative research among physicians, veterinarians, and biomedical scientists to improve the health and quality of life of all species.
