College of Veterinary Medicine General Scholarship Fund

Description

The College of Veterinary Medicine General Scholarship Fund was created in 2014 to be awarded annually to one Veterinary Medicine student in their 2nd, 3rd, or 4th year in the amount of \$1,000.00. The Financial Aid Committee shall review the students that qualify for the scholarship and select the finalists for the award. The Dean of the College of Veterinary Medicine will make the final recipient selection from the finalists selected by The Financial Aid Committee.

Preference shall be granted to a student who:

Has demonstrated a commitment to serving others

Exhibits qualities of making a lasting contribution to the veterinary profession

Has not yet received recognition or an award

Students must submit an original essay of no more than 500 words that describes their background and interest in veterinary medicine as well as their service to others. Additional criteria that will be evaluated are: academic achievement (minimum GPA of 3.5) and documented financial need.

The scholarship will be used only for expenses directly related to the students' academic program and will not be used for other non-academic expenses (housing and meals). The scholarship will not be awarded directly to students; instead, it will be used to reduce or completely cover the amount the student(s) owe(s) to the College of Veterinary Medicine for academic expenses. MWU will decide the amount of award(s) and how many students will receive a scholarship annually.

Eligibility

Class Year at Time of Application:  1st_year  2nd_year  3rd_year  4th year

Programs: Veterinary Medicine

Students in their 2nd, 3rd and 4th year for the upcoming academic year and meet all scholarship criteria.

Minimum GPA

Veterinary Medicine (3.50)

Criteria/Requirements

Funds will be awarded on a competitive basis to eligible applicants based on the following criteria:

- **40%** - An original essay of no more than 500 words that describes your background and interest in veterinary medicine as well as your service to others.
- **50%** - GPA 3.5 or higher. This requirement is higher than the programs required minimum GPA.
- **10%** - Documented financial need. You must have completed the Financial Aid Application process so that financial need can be evaluated.

Awards made under the program will not be automatically renewed from year to year. Candidates will be reviewed annually; a new essay must be submitted with the new application.

If The Financial Aid Committee and The Dean of the College of Veterinary Medicine fails to select any eligible candidates, funds will be retained and carried forward to the following academic year.

Scholarship recipients are expected to maintain satisfactory academic progress and follow the moral and ethical standards of conduct which are outlined in the "Code of Responsibilities and Rights of the Students of MWU" in Appendix 1 of the MWU Student Handbook. Scholarship recipients will be notified by email and are expected to personally write a thank you note to the donors.
