The one \$1,500.00 Johnson & Johnson Wound Management Scholarships was established for the benefit of second, third or fourth year students enrolled in the Arizona Podiatric Medicine Program at Midwestern University. This fund shall be used to grant a scholarship to a student who has demonstrated knowledge and appreciation for the challenges of acute and chronic wound healing.

Eligibility

Class Year at Time of Application:  1st_year  2nd_year  3rd_year  4th year

Programs: Podiatric Medicine

This fund shall be used to grant a scholarship to a student who will be in their 2nd, 3rd or 4th year for the upcoming award year and has demonstrated knowledge of and appreciation for the challenges of acute and chronic wound healing.

Minimum GPA

Podiatric Medicine (3.00)

Criteria/Requirements

Funds will be awarded on a competitive basis to eligible applicants based on the following criteria:

- **60%** - Original 500 word essay which explains your knowledge and appreciation for the challenges of acute and chronic wound healing (**40%**) while demonstrating commitment to podiatric medicine (**20%**).
- **20%** - GPA 3.0 or higher.
- **20%** - Documented financial need. You must have completed the Financial Aid Application process so that financial need can be evaluated.

Awards made under the program will not be automatically renewed from year to year. Candidates will be reviewed annually; a new essay must be submitted with the new application.

If the Financial Aid Committee fails to select any eligible candidates, funds will be retained and carried forward to the following academic year.

Scholarship recipients are expected to maintain satisfactory academic progress and follow the moral and ethical standards of conduct which are outlined in the "Code of Responsibilities and Rights of the Students of MWU" in Appendix 1 of the MWU Student Handbook. Scholarship recipients will be notified by email and are expected to personally write a thank you note to the donors; the recipient authorizes Midwestern University to forward a photo to the donor.
