Logan Doseck Memorial Scholarship

Description

The Midwestern University College of Dental Medicine Class of 2020 established the Logan Doseck Memorial Scholarship to honor their friend and classmate Logan. In August 2016, 141 students began their dream to become Doctors of Dental Medicine at Midwestern University. One of these students was 24-year-old Logan Doseck from Fort Wayne, Indiana. During their first week of classes, students were asked to pick a word that best described what we thought was needed to be happy and successful in dental school. Below is an excerpt from what Logan wrote about himself:


“Opportunistic. I imagine my ideal self as someone that is happy with them self and shares this positivity with others. My personal happiness directly relates to how I can impart happiness to others. Being opportunistic is key to success in dental school and to personal bliss.”

Despite Logan’s optimism, his life was far from perfect. At age four he was diagnosed with Cystic Fibrosis resulting in physiotherapy and aerosolized treatments twice a day. In 2014, Logan went into acute liver failure and shortly thereafter, a coma. His family was told to prepare to take him off life support, but Logan miraculously recovered. In 2015, Logan was given another chance at life with a much-needed liver transplant. Logan continued to pursue his career dreams by completing prerequisites, taking the Dental Admissions Test, and started dental school at Midwestern University. Sadly, during the first quarter, Logan faced additional medical challenges and passed away. After his passing, we learned that Logan had signed a directive to be an organ donor and in his selfless compassion and generosity, Logan has given three people new leases on life.

Eligibility

Class Year at Time of Application:  1st year  2nd year  3rd year  4th year

Programs: Dental Medicine

Dental students in their 2nd, 3rd and 4th years for the upcoming academic year. **This \$750.00 scholarship will be reviewed by The Financial Aid Committee and a pool of candidates will be selected. The final candidates will be reviewed and selected by the College of Dental Medicine - Arizona Scholarship Committee.** The funds will not be awarded directly to the student; they may only be used for tuition, books and other expenses directly related to the academic program (housing, meals, and other non-academic expenses should not be covered by the scholarship). Funds will be used to reduce or completely cover the amount the student owes to the college for academic expenses.

Minimum GPA

Dental Medicine (3.25)

Criteria/Requirements

- **50%** An original essay of 500 words demonstrating leadership and community service detailing your experience volunteering for the elderly and / or children in the past, present and future
- **25%** GPA 3.25 or better
- **25%** Financial need

Awards made under the program will not be automatically renewed from year to year. Candidates will be reviewed annually; a new essay must be submitted with the new application.

Scholarship recipients are expected to maintain satisfactory academic progress and follow the moral and ethical standards of conduct which are outlined in the "Code of Responsibilities and Rights of the Students of MWU" in Appendix 1 of the MWU Student Handbook. Scholarship recipients will be notified by email and are expected to personally write a thank you note to the donors; the recipient authorizes Midwestern University to forward a photo to the donor.
