### Meyer Friedlander & Milton Klasky Tikkun Olam Scholarship

#### Description


The one \$1,250.00 Meyer Friedlander & Milton Klasky Tikkun Olam Scholarship is awarded each year to a Podiatric Medicine Student in their 2nd, 3rd or 4th year. The scholarship name, in part, comes from the Hebrew expression, "Tikkun Olam" which means "healing the world" and best represents the lives of Meyer Friedlander & Milton Klasky, fathers of Gary Friedlander, DPM and Pat Friedlander, Gary's wife and Milton's daughter.

The two men were deeply committed to social change and helping others. They never said "no" to others when asked to help and were always there to provide encouragement, time and financial support to the needs of others. Meyer Friedlander and Milton Klasky were strong proponents of education and provided support and encouragement to their children to believe in and achieve their educational dreams.

#### Minimum GPA

There are no minimum GPA requirements for this scholarship opportunity.

#### Criteria/Requirements

**A minimum of five applications is highly desired**

Funds will be awarded on a competitive basis to eligible applicants based on the following criteria:

- **80%** - An original essay of 500 words describing your community service and leadership involvement and participation. Students whose life exemplifies helping others even in the midst of a busy academic schedule. Community service (**40%**) and leadership (**40%**) are both important. Leadership is important because leadership exemplifies a higher level of commitment.

- **20%** - One letter of recommendation referencing your community service and leadership abilities.
- Please upload a personal photo.

**The Friedlander’s are not looking for service that springs from a church, synagogue or religious affiliation. However, they will look favorably at service within a religiously affiliated non-profit such as the St. Vincent de Paul Shelter, UMOM Homeless Shelter, etc. They consider organizations like these to be forms of community service that do not necessarily spring from a religious affiliation.**

Awards will be made by Dr. and Mrs. Friedlander under the program and will not be automatically renewed from year to year. Candidates will be reviewed annually; a new essay must be submitted with the new application.

If Dr. and Mrs. Friedlander are not able to find a suitable candidate, funds will be retained and carried forward to the following academic year.

Scholarship recipients are expected to maintain satisfactory academic progress and follow the moral and ethical standards of conduct which are outlined in the “Code of Responsibilities and Rights of the Students of MWU” in Appendix 1 of the MWU Student Handbook. Scholarship recipients will be notified by email and are expected to personally write a thank you note to the donors; the recipient authorizes Midwestern University to forward a photo to the donor.
