#### Minimum GPA

This scholarship opportunity has a minimum GPA requirement of 2.00 for all programs.

#### Criteria/Requirements

Funds will be awarded on a competitive basis to eligible student applicants based upon the following criteria:

- Priority given to married students with at least one child.
- Original 100 to 500-word essay that describes how being married and having children has influenced your goal of becoming an osteopathic physician.
- Academic standing (must meet minimum GPA standards per MWU catalog).
- Demonstrated financial need. You must have completed the Financial Aid Application process so that financial need can be evaluated.
