#### **Eligibility**

**Class Year at Time of Application:**  1st\_year  2nd\_year  3rd\_year  4th\_year

**Programs:** Osteopathic Medicine

2nd, 3rd and 4th year medical students. The scholarship recipients will be selected by the Chicago College of Osteopathic Medicine Scholarship Committee. The individual scholarship amounts range from \$1,300 to \$10,000.

#### **Minimum GPA**

This scholarship opportunity has a minimum GPA requirement of 2.00 for all programs.

#### **Criteria/Requirements**

Funds will be awarded on a competitive basis to eligible student applicants based upon the following criteria:

- Original 100 to 500-word essay that describes the qualities you have that will make you an excellent osteopathic physician.
- Participation in extracurricular activities. Please submit a bulleted or formatted list, at the end of your essay, of the extracurricular activities that you are involved in. Include the number of hours spent on each activity. **Important** – Extracurricular activities must be in the same document as your essay.
- Academic standing (must meet minimum GPA standards per MWU catalog).
- Demonstrated financial need. You must have completed the Financial Aid Application process so that financial need can be evaluated.
