Arthur G. Dobbelaere, Ph.D., Student Scholarship

Description

The Arthur G. Dobbelaere, Ph.D., Student Scholarship was established in 2018 after the passing of long-time executive and beloved colleague, Dr. Arthur G. Dobbelaere. Dr. Dobbelaere was a member of the Midwestern University Board of Trustees for five years before serving as Executive Vice President and Chief Operating Officer of Midwestern University, a position he held since 1995. In his role, he masterfully managed the projects related to the design and construction of 52 buildings on both campuses. Shortly after his passing, Midwestern University faculty and staff raised funds for this scholarship in his honor.

Since Dr. Dobbelaere was instrumental in the lives of students from each program and college at the university, one scholarship will be distributed to a student from each campus annually. The students will be selected by the Midwestern University Scholarship Committee on each campus.
