Eligibility

Class Year at Time of Application: 1st year 2nd year 3rd year 4th year

Programs: Osteopathic Medicine

2nd, 3rd, and 4th year medical students. The scholarship recipient will be selected by the Chicago College of Osteopathic Medicine Scholarship Committee for this \$2,700 award.

Minimum GPA

This scholarship opportunity has a minimum GPA requirement of 2.00 for all programs.

Criteria/Requirements

Funds will be awarded on a competitive basis to eligible student applicants based upon the following criteria:

- Original 100 to 500-word essay that describes a major challenge facing health care providers of your hometown in Michigan and how you will implement changes in your own practice that you feel would help address these issues for Michigan residents.
- Planning to return to the state of Michigan to practice osteopathic medicine.
- Academic standing (must meet minimum GPA standards per MWU catalog).
- Demonstrated financial need. You must have completed the Financial Aid Application process so that financial need can be evaluated.
