Criteria/Requirements

Funds will be awarded on a competitive basis to eligible student applicants based upon the following criteria:

- Original 100 to 300-word essay. Dr. Hakes valued service to others. Please focus the essay on your service and volunteer efforts (past, present, and future) and why you merit this award.
- Academic standing (must meet minimum GPA standards per MWU catalog).
- Demonstrated financial need. You must have completed the Financial Aid Application process so that financial need can be evaluated.
