#### **Frederick E. Hecker, D.O. and Robert R. Magliocco, D.O. Memorial Scholarship**

##### **Description**

In 2002, the Lakeview Foundation established the Frederick E. Hecker, D.O. Scholarship Fund and offered Midwestern University and the Chicago College of Osteopathic Medicine the opportunity to provide financial assistance to qualified students.

This scholarship was created in memory of Frederick E. Hecker, D.O. who was considered to be a leader in osteopathic medicine in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. He and two other osteopathic physicians founded Lakeview Hospital in 1944 and this was the impetus behind the expansion of the institution from 40 beds to 125 beds at a new location. He was a fellow of the American College of Osteopathic Surgeons and served as administrator of the hospital from 1944 - 1975.

The Lakeview Foundation changed the scholarship name to the Frederick E. Hecker, D.O. and Robert R. Magliocco, D.O. Memorial Scholarship. This was done to honor the memory of CCOM alumnus, Robert R. Magliocco, D.O. '49 who was instrumental in the establishment of this scholarship. Dr. Magliocco passed away in 2013.

2nd, 3rd and 4th year medical students. Five qualified recipients will each receive a \$10,000 scholarship. The scholarship recipients will be selected by the CCOMAA Board of Governors.

##### **Minimum GPA**

This scholarship opportunity has a minimum GPA requirement of 3.25 for all programs.

##### **Criteria/Requirements**

Funds will be awarded on a competitive basis to eligible student applicants based upon the following criteria:

- One page essay that outlines your desire to practice osteopathic medicine after graduation.
- Demonstrated leadership and community service experience (included in essay).
- Achieved a grade point average of 3.25 or higher.

- Demonstrated financial need. You must have completed the Financial Aid application process so that financial need can be evaluated.
