#### **Stephen K. Mihalich Memorial Clinical Rotation Fund**

##### **Description**

The Stephen K. Mihalich Memorial Clinical Rotation Fund shall be awarded to one or more students based on financial need and who are awarded in their third or fourth years at CCOM. The intent of the fund is to assist as many students as possible each year, provided that sufficient income and qualified students exist.

Students who are planning to complete a clinical rotation either outside of Illinois or in another country may apply. Students must comply with all MWU policies related to clinical rotations, including obtaining the appropriate permissions and approvals from the College. The Financial Aid Committee shall review the students qualifying for the fund and select the final recipient(s) based solely on financial need.

The Stephen K. Mihalich Memorial Clinical Rotation Fund may be used only for travel costs (airline, housing, meals) and other expenses directly related to the students' out-of-state or international rotation experience.

##### **Minimum GPA**

This scholarship opportunity has a minimum GPA requirement of 2.00 for all programs.

##### **Criteria/Requirements**

Funds will be awarded on a competitive basis to eligible student applicants based upon the following criteria:

- Original 100 to 500-word essay that describes the qualities you have that will make you an excellent osteopathic physician.
- Participation in extracurricular activities. Please submit a bulleted or formatted list, at the end of your essay, of the extracurricular activities that you are involved in. Include the number of hours spent on each activity. **Important – Extracurricular activities must be in the same document as your essay.**
- Academic standing (must meet minimum GPA standards per MWU catalog).

- Demonstrated financial need. You must have completed the Financial Aid Application process so that financial need can be evaluated.
