Criteria/Requirements

Funds will be awarded on a competitive basis to eligible student applicants based upon the following criteria:

- Original 100 to 500-word essay that describes your community service involvement and participation.
- One (1) MWU faculty or staff member letter referencing your community service participation and leadership abilities. Or the Letter of Recommendation may come from the individual you report to at the community service organization.
- Academic standing (must meet minimum GPA standards per MWU catalog).
- Demonstrated financial need. You must have completed the Financial Aid Application process so that financial need can be evaluated.
