The Michael B. Tierney, D.O. and Cynthia W. Tierney, BSN, RN Student Scholarship Fund was established in 2014 through an estate gift of Mrs. Tierney in memory of her husband for the benefit of Chicago College of Osteopathic Medicine students. Dr. Tierney, who was a surgeon and a Colonel in the United States Air Force, also was honored by his wife with the naming of the Michael B. Tierney, D.O. Anatomy Laboratory at Midwestern University. Preference is given to students with a particular interest in a specialty such as ENT or Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery.

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Eligibility

Programs: Osteopathic Medicine

3rd and 4th year medical students. Two qualified recipients will each receive a \$9,000 scholarship selected by the Chicago College of Osteopathic Scholarship Committee.

Minimum GPA

This scholarship opportunity has a minimum GPA requirement of 3.25 for all programs.

Criteria/Requirements

Funds will be awarded on a competitive basis to an eligible student applicant based upon the following criteria:

- Original 500-word essay highlighting one recent act of compassion you have provided to another person. The essay should also include the answer to these questions: what are you doing right now to maintain a healthy lifestyle, have you been involved in an instance where laughter is the best medicine, and what motivates you to pursue a specialty in ENT or Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery?
- Achieved a GPA of 3.25 or higher.
- Preference given to students interested in ENT or Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery.
- Must be a U.S. Citizen
- Demonstrated financial need. You must have completed the Financial Aid Application process so that financial need can be evaluated.
