Arizona College of Dental Medicine Diversity Scholarship

Description

The College of Dental Medicine Arizona Diversity Scholarship shall be awarded annually to 3 or more students in their 1st, 2nd, 3rd year and/or an incoming students at the College of Dental Medicine-Arizona. Recipients must be an underrepresented minority, as defined by the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA). Scholarship recipients will be selected by the College of Dental Medicine-Arizona Scholarship Committee. There are several \$10,000.00 awards for the Arizona College of Dental Medicine Diversity Scholarship for the academic year of 2023-2024.

- American Indian or Alaska Native: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North America, and who maintains cultural identification through tribal affiliation or community recognition.
- Black or African American: A person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa.
- Hispanic or Latino: A person of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American, or other Spanish culture or origin without regard to race.
- Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands.

The scholarship will be used only for tuition, books, and other expenses directly related to the student(s) academic program. The scholarship will not be awarded directly to students; instead, it shall be used to reduce or completely cover the amount the student(s) owe(s) to the College of Dental Medicine-Arizona for academic expenses.

- Financial need you must complete the FAFSA application.
- GPA 2.0 for continuing students and max total science GPA from the applicant's deposited admissions application.
- 500-600-word essay on commitment to diversity through leadership roles, past academic projects, research, and community service activities.
- Preference will be given to first-generation college students.
