College of Graduate Studies Dean's Scholarship

Midwestern University (MWU) and the College of Graduate Studies (CGS) are committed to supporting academic excellence and student success. The CGS Scholarship is a merit- and need-based award for outstanding students pursuing a Master of Arts (MA) or Master of Biomedical Sciences (MBS) degree at MWU.

The CGS Dean's Scholarship waives tuition for MA and MBS-1 Students for the Spring Quarter. MBS-1 students who are awarded the scholarship and maintain eligibility, with no failures, until Winter Quarter of year two will automatically be awarded a second waiver of the tuition for Spring Quarter of year two. MBS-2 students who meet the eligibility criteria in the second year may also apply in Winter Quarter.

CGS believes that supporting a broad range of students contributes to advancement, innovation, and excellence in biomedical research, patient care, and healthcare delivery.

To be eligible for this scholarship, the applicant must:

- Be a current CGS MA, MBS-1, or MBS-2 student at MWU.
- Demonstrate commitment to leadership roles, academic projects, community service activities, and/or research.
- Have a minimum cumulative Biomedical Sciences Program GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale, and no failures in any class. The CGS has the right to withdraw the scholarship due to academic or professional issues.
- Complete the Financial Aid Application process to demonstrate financial need.
- Submit a personal statement, no more than 500 words (and must not be AI generated), that addresses your commitment to leadership roles, academic projects, community service activities, and/or research.

Applications will be available during the winter quarter each year. Preference will be given to first-generation college students (include in your personal statement).
